- This permit is for individual use of fireworks at the location listed and on the fireworks display date (July 1 through July 7 only). A separate application must be completed for each day requested.
- The City of Muskego requires proof of homeowners insurance.

## City of Muskego-Municipal Code

### Section 9.03(3)(b) through (i), USE OF FIREWORKS.

- (b) Any fireworks use shall be subject to the following requirements:
  - 1. Wind velocity shall not be more than 15 miles per hour as recorded by the U.S. Weather Bureau, Milwaukee, Wisconsin.
  - 2. Wind direction at the time of use shall be away from buildings or other combustible materials and structures and shall not carry fireworks onto any adjoining buildings or so as to cause annoyance or danger to other persons or property.
  - 3. Sufficient firefighting implements and personnel shall be available at the scene to control any fire which may be caused by the fireworks use.
- (c) Fireworks may be used between 11:00AM. and 11:00PM. (Ord. #1337 – 02/24/11)
- (d) Only the permit holder may discharge fireworks and is responsible in case of a violation of this section. (Ord. #1337 – 02/24/11)
- (e) Upon conviction on any citation issued under this section, and/or written complaints filed with the City, or a written warning issued to an individual from the police department, a person's application for a permit to use fireworks shall be reviewed by the Muskego Finance Committee. The failure of an individual to appear before the Finance Committee will result in the individual's application for a permit being denied. **All permit applications must be filed on or before the third Friday in June.** (Ord. #1337 – 02/24/11)
- (f) No person in the possession of fireworks pursuant to this section may resell those fireworks in the City of Muskego.
- (g) The permit the City issues for the use of fireworks will be printed on bright colored paper stock and must be displayed by people taking out such permit so that it is visible from the street. (Ord. #912 - 03/20/97)
- (h) The type of indemnity bond or liability insurance that may be required pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes §167.10(3)(e) is required in the City of Muskego. (Ord. #912 - 03/20/97)
- (i) A fee for said permit, shall be established from time to time by Resolution of the Common Council, and must be submitted at the time of application. (Ord. #912 - 03/20/97)
