This will be an open-house meeting to allow the public to view and comment on the preliminary proposed layout that the County has designed based on the many stakeholder meetings that have taken place over the past year. The meeting will further be used to discuss the overall project and to gather your input and comments on the proposed design.

The City of Muskego, Waukesha County, and their Consultant team (Ayres & Associates) will be on hand to display the proposed layout. Further, the City of Muskego's streetscaping consulting team, Planning and Design Institute, will also be on hand to discuss the proposed streetscaping aesthetics of the roadway.

The public is invited to stop in anytime between 4 and 7 PM to get their questions answered and to provide further comment on the proposed design so that final design decisions can be made.
