PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Plan Commission of the City of Muskego will hold a Public Hearing at 7:00 PM on Tuesday, November 16, 2004, at the City Hall, W182 S8200 Racine Avenue, to consider the following:

Upon the petition of Eric and Adam Rusdahl shall the following described land as addressed as W135 S8266 Durham Drive be granted a Conditional Use in accordance with Section 6.03 of the Muskego Zoning Ordinance for the purpose of defining a barn as a rustic structure located in the NW 1/4 of Section 13 along Durham Drive:

Tax Key No. 2210.989

Rustic Structures are any permanent accessory structure or building which is distinctly set apart and unique from other structures and buildings due to its construction technique, materials, age, local historic significance or design, and characteristic of past agricultural practices or rural life, whether presently utilized or not for agricultural practice and which is structurally safe at the time conditional use is applied for.

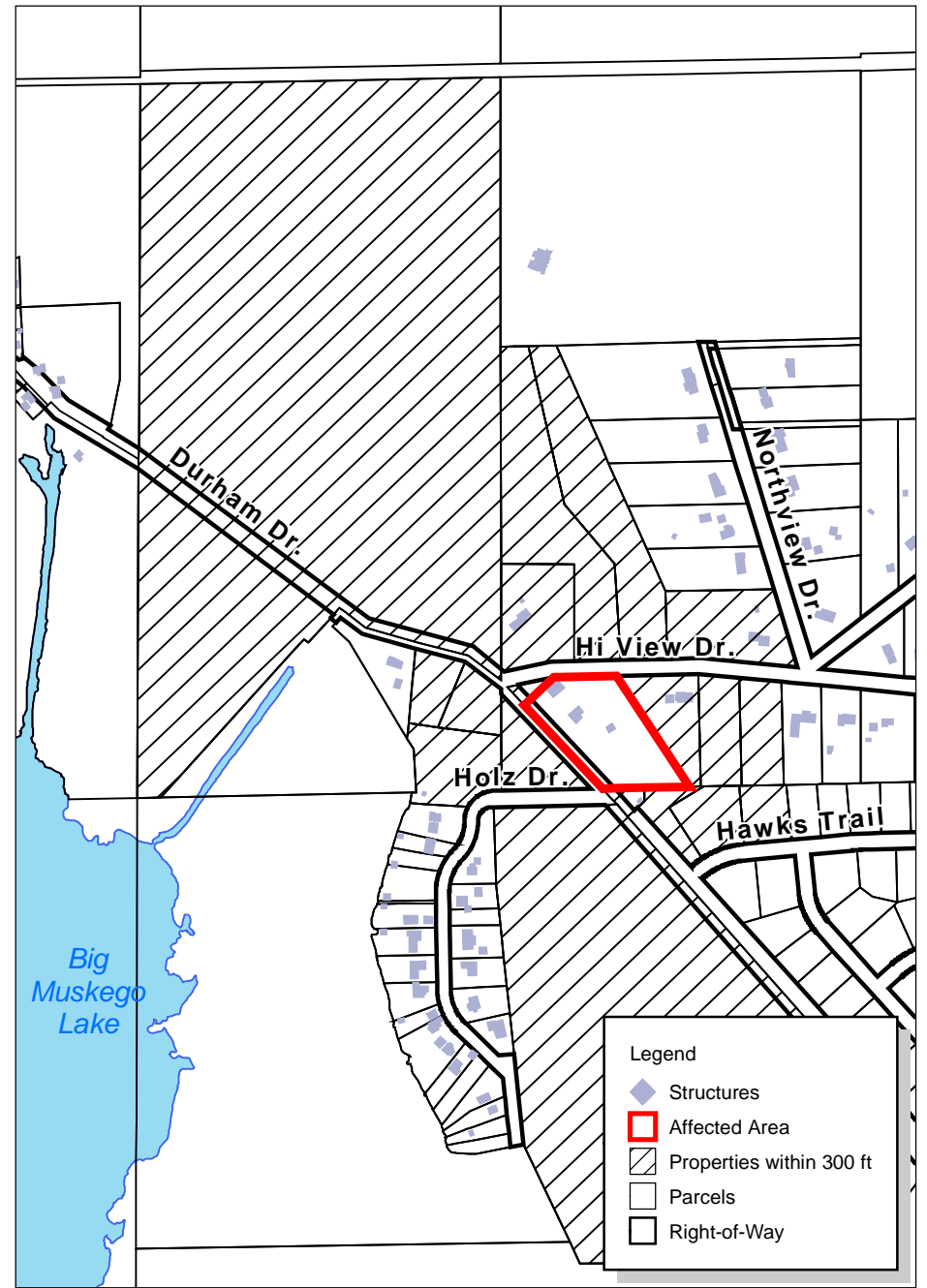
If granted conditional use status, the Rustic Structure is not required to comply with the location, area, height, and architectural requirements for detached accessory structures in the district.
