RULES & REGULATIONS FOR USE OF TENNIS COURTS

When not used by the regular high school programs, then Muskego High School courts are available to the general public. The tennis courts at the City parks are available for general public use Monday through Sunday during park hours (5:00 a.m.-Dusk) unless a lesson program sponsored by the Parks and Recreation Department is in progress during the summer months. We ask that you observe the following rules:

If players are waiting to use the court, a time limit must be observed: one hour for a singles match; one and one-half hours for a doubles match.

Tennis shoes only are allowed on the courts.

Courts are used on a first-come, first-served basis, except during school use or Parks and Recreation Department organized use.

It is the goal of the Parks and Recreation Department to have at least one court "open" during their lesson schedule.

Use of bad language will not be tolerated. Remember, a good tennis player is always a courteous one.

Adults have priority over children under the age of 15 on week nights after 5:00 p.m. during the months of June, July and August.

No alcoholic beverages are allowed on the courts or on school property.

No smoking on the courts or on school property.

Bicycles and motor vehicles are not permitted on the courts.

TENNIS COURT POLICY

Reservations are not required except for the Muskego High School north courts; however, if players are waiting to use the court, a time limit must be observed: one hour for a singles match; one and one-half hours for a doubles match.

Tennis shoes only are allowed on the courts.

Courts are used on a first-come, first-served basis, except during school use or Parks and Recreation Department organized use.

These courts are available for general public use Monday through Sunday unless a lesson program sponsored by the Parks and Recreation Department is in progress during the summer months and/or a recognized school program or match play is in progress during the school season.

It is the goal of the Parks and Recreation Department to have at least one court "open" during their lesson schedule.

Use of bad language will not be tolerated. Remember, a good tennis player is always a courteous one.

Adults have priority over children under the age of 15 on week nights after 5:00 p.m. during the months of June, July and August.

No alcoholic beverages are allowed on the courts or on school property.

No smoking on the courts or on school property.

Bicycles and motor vehicles are not permitted on the courts.

TENNIS COURT RESERVATIONS

Residents in Muskego may reserve tennis courts during the summer. Reservations for courts will only be issued at the Parks and Recreation Department office during the hours of 8:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m. There will be a \$1.00 charge for this reservation. **YOU MUST HAVE PROOF OF MUSKEGO RESIDENCY TO RESERVE A COURT.**

Individuals may reserve one court for one hour and it must be at least 24 hours in advance of the time reserved. Your reservation will give you priority to use one court for one hour. All tennis players must observe this permit. There will be no attendants on duty.

Priority Levels for Tennis Court Reservations

- Priority I—Muskego/Norway School District Interscholastic Athletics
- Priority II—Muskego Parks and Recreation Department Programs.
- Priority III—Muskego-based Individuals and Groups
- Priority IV—Non-Muskego-based Individuals and Groups (Leagues)

Fees Based on Priority Level

Priority I—No Fee

Priority II—No Fee

Priority III—\$1.00/Hour, Individuals; \$2.50/Hour, Court Groups

Priority IV—\$2.00/Hour, Individuals; \$5.00/Hour, Court Groups

ALL PLAYERS:

- Please use tennis etiquette and observe posted rules.
- Please limit play to one hour unless no one is using court.
- Tennis shoes must be worn—**NO STREET SHOES.**
- Parks and Recreation Department has priority for court usage.
